The purpose of this measure is to urge the Division of State  
Parks of the Department of Land and Natural Resources to assess  
potentially hazardous ocean conditions at beach parks and ensure  
that safety concerns are addressed prior to undertaking access  
improvements that will increase use, and to provide information  
about potentially hazardous conditions at state beach parks on the  
division's website and in its printed materials.

Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your  
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 28 and  
recommends its adoption.
