Sir:

Your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 185, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CHILD CARE PROVIDERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to require child care providers licensed or registered by the Department of Human Services to obtain and maintain liability insurance coverage beginning January 1, 2019.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from fifty-six individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Human Services.

Your Committee finds that since many parents must work full time, infant child care is essential for many local families. Through the Department of Human Services, the State regulates and inspects these child care facilities to ensure that all children are safe and healthy. Requiring all licensed or registered child care providers to obtain and maintain liability insurance coverage may bring assurance to families who require child care services and allow opportunities for legal recourse for parents whose children are not properly cared for.

Your Committee has amended this measure by inserting an effective date of July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion. As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 185, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 185, S.D. 2.
