Small Business Regulatory Review Board's power to review proposed
and amended state and county administrative rules, in addition to
adopted rules, that impact small businesses.

Tourism; Small Business Regulatory Review Board; Kamaile Academy
Public Charter School; Page Marketing, Inc.; Hawaii Business
League; Chamber of Commerce Hawaii; and one individual. Your

Bureau.


Your Committees find that there is a need to clarify the
powers of the Small Business Regulatory Review Board in order to
clearly define the purview of the Board to ensure that the small
business community, state and county agencies, Hawaii business
chambers, and trade organizations have a clear understanding of
the Board's authority. Your Committees believe that this
clarification will prevent any misunderstandings in the future.
