"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to support the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program on Oahu by establishing and appropriating funds for one full-time equivalent (1.00 FTE) permanent program specialist IV position for the City and County of Honolulu and for contract services through the Office of the Long-Term Care Ombudsman in the Counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui.

The State Long-Term Care Ombudsman, Americans for Democratic Action, AARP Hawaii, Legacy Hilo Rehabilitation & Nursing Center, and several individuals testified in support of this measure. The Executive Office on Aging, County of Hawaii Mayor, County of Hawaii Office of Aging, and two individuals commented on this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

(1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2070, to facilitate further discussion; and

Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Human Services and Health that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
