fund. Appropriates funds.

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

AEN/WTL, JDC

Status & Testimony Clarifies that state, county, and authorized agents' authority to enter private property to control and eradicate invasive species also applies when there is a reasonable suspicion that invasive

species are present on that property.

SB 2645

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

AEN/WTL, CPH

Status & Testimony

Requires, for any proposed action involving construction for which an environmental impact statement has been accepted by an agency but for which construction has not commenced within five years of acceptance of the statement, the developer of the construction project to exercise due diligence with respect to any changes in the community where the project is planned and requires developers to hold community discussion and feedback sessions to discuss relevant and new concerns regarding the project.
