RELATING TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS.

CPC/JUD, FIN

Amends the Hawaii Nonprofit Corporations Act to: clarify that a public benefit corporation may not purchase its memberships; clarify that the term "director" only includes those who have the authority to vote as a member of a board; clarify that a corporation with members may provide for appointment by some other person, or designation, of some of its directors; and allow the attorney general more time to review a proposed sale of substantially all of the assets of a corporation, other than in the regular course of its activities.
