SB2025 RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

Status and Testimony

Beginning January 1, 2019, requires all health plans in the State, including EUTF health plans and medicaid managed care programs, to provide coverage for the treatment of homelessness. Requires the department of human services to seek a section 1115 waiver to amend the state medicaid plan to include housing and supportive housing services for chronically homeless

individuals.

RELATING TO BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS.

Status and Testimony Exempts from licensure requirements for behavior analysis certain

individuals who implement applied behavior analysis services or plans under the oversight or direction of others. Updates and standardizes the terminology used to refer to behavior analysts.
