SB3064 RELATING TO UTILITY POLES. CPH

Status and Testimony Prohibits public utilities from installing a new utility pole within ten

feet of an existing utility pole; unless the original utility pole will be removed within ninety days of installing the new utility pole.

<u>SB2524</u> <u>RELATING TO COUNTY LAND USE REQUIREMENTS.</u>

Status and Testimony Requires condominium property regimes to comply with county

subdivision requirements. Allows the real estate commission to adopt rules that require a developer to seek county council

approval for significant projects. Requires agricultural lands that are subdivided and leased for agricultural uses or activities to

comply with county subdivision standards.
