SB 2903, SD1 (SSCR2804) Status	RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Appropriates funds to the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation for continuance and administration of the manufacturing development program. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	EDB, FIN
SB 48, SD3 (SSCR2846) Status	RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY. Appropriates moneys to the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation for its continued operation. SB 2670, SD3 (SSCR2910) Status	RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS. Codifies sustainable development goals based on the United Nations' Global Goal nine, relating to industry, innovation, and infrastructure. (SD3)	EDB, JUD, FIN
SB 2678, SD3 (SSCR2907) Status	RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS. Codifies sustainable development goals based on the United Nations' Global Goal seventeen, strengthening implementation.	EDB, JUD, FIN
