Status and Testimony Limits the number of standardized tests a student shall take in a

school year. Requires the board of education to conduct a statewide survey of school administrators and teachers to determine the time spent on preparing for standardized tests and

the impact of preparation time on the quality of instruction.

SB2353 RELATING TO DISCRIMINATION IN EDUCATION. EDU., JDC

Status and Testimony Prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex, including gender

identity or expression, or sexual orientation, in any state

educational program or activity, or in any educational program or activity that receives state financial assistance. Takes effect

1/1/2019.
