RELATING TO POLYSTYRENE FOAM CONTAINERS.

Prohibits the sale of polystyrene foam containers and serving of

prepared foods using polystyrene foam containers statewide.

Authorizes the department of health to include within its administrative rules a requirement for prepared food vendors to educate their

customers about proper disposal of nonreusable food containers and

litter reduction. Takes effect 7/1/2019. (SD2)
