SB 2346, SD2

RELATING TO ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY.

JUD, FIN

(HSCR1366-18) Status

Establishes the address confidentiality program within the Department of the Attorney General to help survivors of domestic abuse, sexual assault, and stalking to relocate and keep the location of their physical address confidential. Makes an appropriation to the Department of the Attorney General that is effective 7/1/2049. Effective 7/1/2050.

SB 3025, SD1, HD1

(HSCR1389-18)

Status

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

CPC, FIN

Requires franchisees to disclose their non-participation in advertising campaigns of the franchisor in which discounts or promotions are offered. Prohibits franchisors from limiting or restricting the disclosures. Exempts and defines "quick service restaurants."
