SB 2758 RELATING TO HOUSING. PSM/HOU, WAM

Status & Testimony

Establishes expedited approvals for affordable housing projects seeking district boundary amendments for land areas of fifteen acres or less under the jurisdiction of the counties, as well as

expedited approvals by the Hawaii Community Development

Authority.

SB 2594 RELATING TO HOUSING. HOU/PSM, WAM

Status & Requires that construction and renovation of publicly funded residential housing incorporate housing visitability standards.

SB 2417 RELATING TO HOUSING. HOU/PSM, WAM

Waives exaction requirements and zoning requirements for housing projects where all units are affordable to persons and families with household income at or below one hundred forty per cent of the area median income. Makes such projects also eligible for additional exemptions pursuant to section 201H-38,

HRS.

SB 2884 RELATING TO TEMPORARY HOUSING. HOU/PSM, WAM

Allows the State to construct temporary emergency transitional housing for homeless persons without going through permitting process. Authorizes the State to cooperate with nonstate actors

to find permanent housing and other programs for homeless

persons.

Status & Testimony RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

Clarifies the interests that must be represented by members of the HCDA representing community development districts. Requires the senate president and the speaker of the house of representatives to nominate representatives of the several community development districts to the HCDA, and requires those representatives to be nominated only as a resident representative or a small business owner or nonprofit organization representative, but not both.
