SB 2738 RELATING TO FOUND ELECTRONIC DEVICES. PSM/TRE, WAM

Clarifies that found electronic devices that may contain personal Status & information shall be sanitized before providing the unclaimed **Testimony** property to finders or disposing of the property by public auction

or other means.
