SB 2326 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TOWING. Prohibits a towing company from towing a vehicle that is parked in a parking stall that would otherwise require a person to pay for parking by means of a ticket issuing machine if the ticket issuing machine is inoperable.	TRE, JDC
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES. Provides an income tax credit of thirty-five per cent of the actual cost, up to \$1,500,000, for each ocean thermal energy conversion system constructed for the purpose of research and development. Applies to taxable years after December 31, 2017.	TRE, WAM
