SB 2849, SD1 (SSCR2592) RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

(SSCR259) Status Classifies certain former military vehicles as special interest vehicles. Enables owners of former military vehicles to apply for registration with the director of finance of the county in which the former military

vehicle resides. Makes conforming amendments. (SD1)

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

Assesses a \$10 motor vehicle importation fee for each motor vehicle that is imported into the State, due to the county that is the final destination of the vehicle. Provides that revenue from the motor vehicle importation fee shall be expended for the disposal of
