Requires individuals to report use tax liabilities on their individual income tax return and remit payment of use tax with their individual income tax return, if applicable, or report use tax liabilities on a use tax return and remit payment with the return. SB 2484 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ESTATE TAXES. Increases estate taxes for Hawaii net taxable estates valued at over \$10,000,000.	WAM
SB 2506 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Increases the tax on the amount realized from the disposition of Hawaii real property by nonresidents from 5% to 9%. Applies to taxable years after 12/31/17.	WAM
