## **DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):**

SB2337 (SSCR2427) RELATING TO WASTE MANAGEMENT.

GVO/AEN/CPH,

WAM

Status and Testimony

Requires that all state and county agency contractors that dispose of liquid or solid waste to provide a receipt that the waste was received and disposed of at a licensed facility before full payment is made for those contractual services. Allows for partial payment to be made without a receipt and prior to any dumping of waste.

Prohibits alteration or falsification of receipts.

SB3028

(SSCR2262)

Status and Testimony

RELATING TO CHILD SUPPORT.

HMS, WAM

Requires certain amounts of child support moneys collected by the Department of Human Services (DHS) for public assistance of a child to pass through to the family receiving the public assistance. Requires DHS to disregard passed through child support payments when determining the needs of an applicant for or recipient of public assistance.

SB2751 SD1 (SSCR2517) Status and Testimony RELATING TO THE PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER HRE/ETT, WAM FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS.

Amends section 201-76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to expressly place the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration Systems within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. Deletes the executive director of the space center as a member of the board and adds the Chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo. Establishes a ceiling of \$1,000,000 for the Pacific international space center for exploration systems special fund. Repeals the office of aerospace development and transfers all rights, powers, functions, and duties to the Pacific international space center for exploration systems. (SD1)

SB2988 SD1 (SSCR2112) RELATING TO KUPUNA CARE.

CPH/HMS, WAM

Status and Testimony

Requires the Executive Office on Aging to include in its annual report to the legislature a section that details program outcomes. Appropriates \$4,000,000 for implementation of the Kupuna

Caregivers Program. (SD1)

SB2237 SD1 (SSCR2513) Status and Testimony RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

EDU/WTL, WAM

Requires the City and County of Honolulu to transfer to the Department of Education all property upon which a public elementary or intermediate school is situated. Gives the Department of Education power to acquire and hold title to real, personal, or mixed property for use for public educational purposes. Requires legislative approval prior to the sale or gift of lands to which the Department of Education holds title. (SD1)
