SB 2286 RELATING TO STATE SMALL BOAT HARBORS. WTL, WAM

given and include certain information. Requires all public auctions for use permits at the Ala Wai boat harbor to be conducted by the chairperson of the board of land and natural resources or an authorized employee of the department of land and natural resources under the direction of the board of land and natural resources without additional compensation. effect on 8/1/2018.
