<u>SB 2808</u> RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY WTL, JDC

Status & FOR OCEAN RECREATION AND COASTAL AREAS.
Amends the definition of "commercial activity" within section

200-4(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

SB 2974 RELATING TO THE UNIFORM CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR WTL, JDC

Status & VESSELS ACT.

Requires certain vessel owners to apply for a certificate of title within twenty days of becoming an owner or within twenty days of establishing principal use of the vessel in waters of the State. Establishes what information is required to be included in an

application for a certificate of title; how to deal with transfer of vessel ownership and title; rights of a secured party; and rights

of a purchaser other than a secured party.

SB 3105 RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION. WTL, WAM

Status & Authorizes the Department of Land and Natural Resources to assess a fee to visitors accessing Lipoa Point by a maritime commercial vessel. Creates the Lipoa Point Management Special Fund for the management of the Lipoa Point area and

Special Fund for the management of the Lipoa Point area and educate visitors on how funding is used for the management of

the Lipoa Point area.
