HB898, HD1	RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION. Requires franchisees to disclose their non-participation in advertising campaigns of the franchisor in which discounts or promotions are offered. Prohibits franchisors from limiting or restricting the disclosures. (HB898 HD1)	EDB, CPC
HB1520, HD1	RELATING TO INSURANCE. Establishes requirements for regulation of limited-duration health insurance by the Insurance Commissioner. Establishes maximum term, disclosure requirements, rate standards, and form approval requirements. (HB1520 HD1)	HHS, CPC, FIN
<u>HB1812, HD1</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Authorizes a health care surrogate to be an authorized representative to assist a patient with a medicaid application, redetermination of eligibility, and other related communications	HHS, CPC, FIN

HB1816, HD1 RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. HHS, JUD, FIN

Provides for ohana zones for temporary shelter and services in support of permanent housing placements for individuals experiencing homelessness. Limits liability to counties, service providers, and volunteers for services provided in ohana zones. Temporarily exempts ohana zones from building codes. (HB1816 HD1)

HB2155 RELATING TO EDUCATION. HHS, FIN

Creates and appropriates funds for Erin's Law Task Force to review policies, programs, and curricula for educating public school students about sexual abuse and sex trafficking prevention, and report recommendations for the establishment of a program to educate public school children on sexual abuse prevention through age appropriate curricula. Appropriation.

HB2606 RELATING TO TROPIC CARE. HHS, FIN

Appropriates funds for the Tropic Care program of the United States Department of Defense to provide free medical care to individuals in rural areas.

RELATING TO THE MILITARY. HB2696, HD1

VMI, FIN

Appropriates funds for the establishment of one full-time equivalent cyberanalyst position within the state Department of Defense. (HB2696 HD1)

RELATING TO VETERANS. HB2697, HD1

VMI, FIN

Requires the Office of Veterans' Services to organize, coordinate, and conduct an annual State of Hawaii Veterans Summit. Appropriates funds. (HB2697 HD1)

RELATING TO VETERANS. HB2698, HD1

VMI, FIN

Appropriates moneys for the commemoration of the centennial anniversary of World War I and the men and women who served in the war. (HB2698 HD1)

HB2699, HD1 RELATING TO THE ARTS.

VMI/EDB, JUD,

Allows for the establishment and certification of creative districts FIN to promote culture and the arts. Allows for incentives. Requires the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism to submit a report. Appropriates Funds. (HB2699

RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS.

Establishes an income tax credit for host families of foreign exchange students, fellows, and interns. Effective 7/1/2018. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/2018. (HB2700 HD1)
