The State Council on Developmental Disabilities (DD) **STRONGLY SUPPORTS GM 631** to confirm the nomination of Darwin Nagamine for a term to expire June 30, 2020.

representatives, at all times, of local and non-governmental agencies, and private nonprofit groups concerned with services for individuals with DD in the State.

The Governor's nominee meets all the Federal requirements for Council membership. Mr. Nagamine's appointment to the Council would fulfill the Federal requirement for representatives of individuals with DD.

Mr. Nagamine is an energetic individual who would like to help others. He has lead the Question and Answer discussion sessions of the Legislative Forum's in Hilo, Hawaii.
