H.B. 1942 RELATING TO DRIVER'S LICENSING

House Committee on Judiciary

The Department of Transportation (DOT) **supports** H.B. 1942 relating to driver's licensing.

The proposed amendment to Section 286-104.5 addresses the need for Hawaii's law to match the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Final Rule. The DHS' final rule that relates to the REAL ID Act of 2005 allows for only one REAL ID-compliant credential whether a driver's license or state civil identification card.

The proposed amendment to Section 286-104.5 addresses the situation that may occur when a person elects to hold a state civil identification card as their REAL ID-compliant credential and permits that person to obtain a non-compliant limited purpose driver's license.
