SUBJECT: House Bill No. 2589, H.D. 2, Relating to Motorcycles

I am Ryan Nishibun, Major of the Traffic Division of the Honolulu Police Department (HPD), City and County of Honolulu.

The HPD opposes the passage of House Bill No. 2589, H.D. 2, Relating to Motorcycles. This bill would allow motorcycles to use designated shoulder lanes when traffic has been stopped for a certain period of time or when there is congestion at a marked or unmarked intersection as a result of a traffic control device. In circumstances where traffic is stopped or slow moving due to congestion, vehicles will tend to overheat or breakdown requiring the use of the shoulders. Drivers unaware of motorcycles operating in a shoulder lane or inexperienced motorcycle operators not paying attention to traffic will increase the risk for motor vehicle collisions and injuries.

Since January 1, 2018, there have been five motorcycle fatalities attributed to operator error. Allowing motorcycles to traverse the shoulders would increase the risk of collisions and injuries.

The HPD urges you to oppose House Bill No. 2589, H.D. 2, in its current form.

Senate Committee on Judiciary

The Department of Transportation (DOT) **supports** H.B. 2589, H.D. 2 relating to motorcycles. This bill allows the DOT to designate shoulders upon which the department may authorize the driving of motorcycles under certain conditions.

The DOT recognizes there are the following concerns:

- Reduces safety for all roadway users. The shoulder is utilized to accommodate stopped vehicles, emergencies, and on arterial roadways, bicyclists and pedestrians.
- On arterial roadways, pedestrian crossing at an unsignalized intersection could be more challenging as motorcycles or motor scooters traveling on the shoulder and/or moving back into the normal travel lane can take away gaps in traffic used by crossing pedestrians or take away shoulder space for pedestrians to safely walk or wait on.
- Increases potential for road rage. Providing preferential treatment for motorcycles or motor scooters has the potential to anger motorists who are waiting patiently in traffic.
- No impact on alleviating congestion. Motorcycles and motor scooters occupy less than half the length of the average motor vehicle.

The DOT will consider the above-listed concerns when determining the areas in which it would be safe to designate shoulders for motorcycle use under certain conditions.

Dear Chair Taniguchi, Vice Chair Rhoads and Members of the Committee:

AAA Hawaii was founded in 1915 in Honolulu and is a leader in motorist services and a strong advocate for traffic safety. With more than 157,000 members, service to and the safety of our members, other motorists, and all road users is our founding and continuing purpose.

We have significant traffic safety concerns with the proposal to allow motorcycles to drive on shoulders in Hawaii, and OPPOSE HB 2589 HD 2. HB 2589 HD 2 authorizes the Department of Transportation to designate shoulders upon which motorcycles may drive under certain conditions when vehicular traffic is stopped as a result of congestion.

Roadway shoulders are designed to accommodate disabled vehicles or traffic law enforcement activities, both of which occur randomly without any advance warning informing motorcyclists of the shoulder blockage. Shoulders are also sometimes used, with little or no advance warning, by vehicles attempting to avoid an imminent collision. HB 2589 HD 2 will exacerbate the already hazardous weaving of motorcycles in and out of shoulders, especially in congested traffic when there is little spacing between consecutive vehicles in the travel lanes.

Furthermore, pavement conditions on shoulders in most locations may not be as suitable as regular travel lanes that are better deigned and better maintained compared to shoulders. Poor pavement conditions on shoulders pose a hazard for the motorcyclists.

Additionally, the presence of potholes, debris, trach, etc. will force motorcyclists to engage in unsafe maneuvers forcing them closer to the pavement edge or congested travel lanes.

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Considering the aforementioned, we believe that allowing motorcycles to drive on shoulders is ill advised and will put traffic safety at risk.

We respectfully urge you to vote NO on HB 2589 HD 2.

As a cofounder and director of Hawaii's largest independent moped shop chain Moped Doctors, We SUPPORT HB2589. Though mopeds are not exactly the same class as motorcycles and/or scooters, we believe that they are similar enough that such a measure, even if mopeds are not allowed to take advantage of this particular bill, its success may allow for a similar measure in the future for mopeds.. As ALL mopeds are air cooled, overheating standing still can be a possible issue. And to the average car driver, there is no Vvsible obvious difference in many cases between a moped (50cc engine and 2 horsepower) with a scooter (motorcycle class but has bigger displacement, then 50cc, more power then 2hp and faster then 30mph). which means that we as riders/drivers of two wheeled (and similar three wheeled vehicles) are all kindred in our vulnerability to the daily dangers from cars (which vastly outnumber us and are way better protected) we share the roads with . Riders of mopeds, motorcycles, scooters, bicycles are ALL similarly vulnerable and any measure which would reduce or eliminate danger to them and a better condition for all drivers overall via a faster, more efficient traffic flow will only do good, save lives and money and should be supported and passed.
