I am Ron Han, Director of the State Office of Veterans' Services. I appreciate this opportunity to provide testimony in strong support of House Concurrent Resolution 175/House Resolution 147 as long as its implementation does not impact or replace the priorities set forth in the Executive Budget.

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has published studies on specific cancers among Vietnam Veterans and has concluded that veterans who served in the U.S. Navy have a higher risk of cancer. More than 30 veteran service organizations clearly support the Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act of 2013 (H.R. 543) in response to those studies.
