In consideration of HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 45/HOUSE RESOLUTION 33 URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PROHIBIT INDIVIDUALS FROM APPROACHING WITHIN FIFTY FEET OF A HAWAIIAN MONK SEAL EXCEPT WHEN PROVIDING AID TO THE HAWAIIAN MONK SEAL

House Concurrent Resolution 45/House Resolution 33 urges the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to prohibit individuals from approaching within fifty feet of a Hawaiian monk seal except when providing aid to the Hawaiian monk seal. **The Department appreciates** the intent of these measures and offers the following comments.

The Department recognizes the importance of Hawaiian monk seal protection and to that effect already works closely under a Joint Enforcement Agreement with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to enforce federal laws that prohibit the harassment of monk seals and federal marine wildlife viewing guidelines that recommend remaining at least 50 yards away.
