In consideration of HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 75/HOUSE RESOLUTION 60 REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO ESTABLISH A KAUAI INVASIVE SPECIES TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE ISSUES OF INVASIVE ANIMALS IN KAUAI

House Concurrent Resolution 75/House Resolution 60 request the Hawaii Department of Agriculture (HDOA) to establish a task force to study the issues of invasive animals on Kauai. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) offers the following comments.

The Department recognizes that invasive animals on Kauai cause a variety of impacts, including agricultural, economic, and environmental. For farmers who experience damage from non-native animals to crops on private property, the Department has a process in place to issue wildlife control permits. Under Hawaii Administrative Rules Chapter 124-7, permits may be issued for the control of game birds, game mammals, introduced wildlife, and introduced wild birds causing damage to agricultural crops. The Department suggests that as an alternative to creating a formal task force, the Kauai County Farm Bureau work with the Department to issue control permits where needed.
