Chair Dela Cruz and Members of the Committee:

The Department of the Attorney General provides the following comment regarding S.B. No. 192, Proposed S.D. 1.

This bill amends the descriptions of capital improvement projects related to the Livestock Feed Mill and the Waste Stream Recycling Facility in the General Appropriations Act of 2015, as amended by the Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2016.

While the Proposed S.D. 1 adds a public purpose declaration to both the Livestock Feed Mill and the Waste Stream Recycling Facility, we believe that the language of the public declaration should be revised as follows, to be consistent with standard form:

"The Legislature finds and declares that the appropriation is in the public <u>interest</u> and for the <u>public's</u> health, safety, and general welfare of the State."
