Chair Dela Cruz and Members of the Committee:

The Department of the Attorney General supports the passage of S.B. No. 2312, S.D. 1.

The bill, as revised, will help ensure that applicants for grants of public moneys do not have delinquent taxes and are in good standing with the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. The S.D. 1 amendments will also ensure that when an applicant is a nonprofit organization, the organization has been granted and maintains tax exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service, and are registered with the Department of the Attorney General under chapter 467B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, if applicable. The bill as currently drafted, will also require a grant applicant to submit other documents that will facilitate a determination of whether the applicant qualifies for the grant under section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
