The League of Women Voters of Hawaii supports SB 2594, that requires that construction and renovation of publicly funded residential housing incorporate housing visitability standards.

We note that this measure is long overdue and that under this proposed measure housing visitability standards are minimum standards to provide accessibility and safety for individuals with disabilities when visiting or using residential space, including, *inter alia*, accessible exterior and interior entryways, a wheelchair accessible full-bathroom, accessible bedroom, and smoke detectors that permit both visible and audible detection of an alarm.
