TESTIMONY ON SENATE BILL NO. 2647, RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELORS.

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN M. MIZUNO, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is Carol Kramer, and I am the Executive Officer of the Mental Health Counselor Program ("Program"). Thank you for the opportunity to testify on S.B. 2647, Relating to Mental Health Counselors, which is a companion to H.B. 2058. The Program strongly supports this measure.

The Program concurs with generalizing the practicum experience requirement by amending the law to require a total of at least six semester hours or ten quarter hours within at least two academic terms, instead of at least three semester hours or five quarter hours per academic term. The total practicum experience hours will remain the same providing no change to consumer protection.
