TESTIMONY ON SENATE BILL NO. 2931, S.D. 1, RELATING TO DENTISTRY.

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN M. MIZUNO, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is Paul Guevara, D.M.D, M.D.S., and I am the Chairperson of the Board of Dental Examiners ("Board"). Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of S.B. 2931, S.D. 1, Relating to Dentistry, which is a companion to H.B. 2149.

S.B. 2931, S.D.1 amends the ethics training requirement for dentists in the continuing education program to six hours of ethics training within the previous two years.

The Board fully supports this S.D.1 version of the measure, as it clarifies that the licensee must complete at least six hours of ethics training in the previous two-year biennial period to comply with the continuing education requirements for renewal.

Please note that companion bill, H.B. 2149 does not incorporate the clarifying language in the H.D. 1. Therefore, the Board strongly recommends passage of this version of the bill.
