S.B. 3002, S.D.1 – Relating to Libraries

To: Chair Woodson, Vice-Chair Woodson and Members of the Committee on Education

The Hawaii State Public Library System (HSPLS) **strongly supports** S.B. 3002, S.D.1, which would authorize the state librarian to designate one or more public library employees to be a notary public, allow designated employees to perform notary services in nongovernmental matters for fees and for the fees to be deposited into the library fee for enhanced services special fund.

Over the years, HSPLS staff have received requests for notary services, particularly in rural areas of the State. S.B.3002, S.D.1, would allow HSPLS employees to become duly qualified and receive commissions as notaries public in government services. Fees charged for notary services will help to support the branch libraries providing the service.
