Testimony in Opposition of SB 593

Sen. Gabbard and Members of the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Environment:

The Pacific Pet Alliance is a Hawai'i non-profit organization that promotes responsible pet ownership through education and advocacy.

While the intent of SB 593 appears to be a good one, to place retired research animals in adoptive homes, the Pacific Pet Alliance finds that this bill is unnecessary to achieve this goal as the research community has already been practicing this. The University of Hawaii for example has a clearly outlined policy for adopting out retired research animals and has a working agreement with the Hawaiian Humane Society to handle the adoptions.
