Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1093, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES,"

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish rules and regulations, including permitting procedures, for transportation network companies operating in the State; and
