begs leave to report as follows:



The Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism, Searider Productions, O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, and a few concerned individuals supported this measure. The University of Hawaii System opposed this measure.
