Your Committees on Labor & Public Employment and Lower & Higher Education, to which was referred H.B. No. 412 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE SALARY OF THE STATE LIBRARIAN,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to amend the State Librarian's salary, which is set by the Board of Education, to be no more than ninety percent of the Superintendent of Education's salary.

The Board of Education testified in support of this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to January 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Labor & Public Employment and Lower & Higher Education that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 412, as amended herein, and recommend that it pass Second Reading in the form


