Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 445, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR WATER REUSE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds for capital improvements to the State's water reuse systems as follows:

- (1) Kanaha Beach Park Greywater Reuse Demonstration Project;
and
- (2) Kealakehe Wastewater Treatment Facility.

The Board of Water Supply of the City and County of Honolulu, Ulupono Initiative, The Nature Conservancy of Hawai'i, Hawaii Community Foundation, One World One Water, and O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i testified in support of this measure.
