<u>HB138, HD1</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires owners and operators of fifteen or more food service establishments to provide calorie information for menu items. (HB138 HD1)	HLT, CPC, FIN
<u>HB139, HD1</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH.  Prohibits the manufacture, sale or distribution of reusable drink and food containers intended for use by children under three and containing bisphenol A. (HB139 HD1)	HLT, CPC, FIN
HB140, HD1	RELATING TO HEALTH.  Provides the same protections under the peer-review process that are afforded to licensed physicians to residents and fellow physicians. (HB140 HD1)	HLT, CPC, FIN

## Committee RE-REFERRAL

### <u>HB141, HD1</u> RELATING TO HEALTH.

HLT, CPC, FIN

Establishes a Telehealth Advisory Council within the DOH to advise the governor in the development and implementation of a comprehensive telehealth plan. Creates a permanent full-time Telehealth Coordinator to facilitate the establishment of infrastructure and policies across State and private entities and appropriates funds. Establishes a task force to reduce barriers in health care system credentialing, privileging, and other administrative processes. Act is repealed January 1, 2022. (HB141 HD1)

#### HB142, HD1 RELATING TO HEALTH.

HLT, CPC

Requires any restaurant that offers a children's meal to offer water, non-flavored milk, or a nondairy milk substitute that has no more than 130 calories per container or serving as the default beverage choice accompanying the meal. (HB142 HD1)

### HB257, HD1 RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

HSH/HSG, FIN

Authorizes the use of private lands for the Ohana Zones Pilot Program. Extends the Ohana Zones Pilot Program to June 30, 2022. Extends the Emergency Department Homelessness Assessment Pilot Program and the Medical Respite Pilot Program to June 30, 2020. (HB257 HD1)

### HB439, HD1 RELATING TO LAND USE.

WLH, FIN

Exempts lands set aside by the Governor for the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation from classification as public land subject to management by the Department of Land and Natural Resources. (HB439 HD1)
