Committee **RE-REFERRAL** RELATING TO FIREWORKS LABELING. **CPC SB152** Corrects labeling dimension with regard to fireworks used for display. RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. **CPC** SB725, SD1 Specifies that a condominium association's proxies and ballots may be destroyed ninety days, rather than thirty days, after an association meeting, unless the election is contested, in which case the documents shall be retained until resolution of the contested election. (SD1) SB816, SD2 RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. LAB/HLT, LMG, Appropriates funds to resolve the compensation differential for **FIN** certain union members for the modified terms, conditions, and compensation practices caused by the transfer of the use and exclusive management and operations of Maui memorial medical center, Kula hospital, and Lanai community hospital from the Hawaii health systems corporation to Maui Health System. (SD2)

SB1126, SD2

RELATING TO REAL ESTATE DISCLOSURE.

WLH/EEP, CPC,
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Beginning on November 1, 2019, requires all vulnerable coastal property sales or transfers to include a sea level rise hazard exposure statement to ensure that new property owners and transferees understand the special hazards, requirements, and limitations that may affect the property. Requires sellers to include whether property is within a sea level rise exposure area in the disclosure statement provided to the buyer. Takes effect 12/31/2050. (SD2)

SB1244, SD2

RELATING TO THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

HLT, JUD, FIN

Clarifies that liability for illegally selling tobacco products and electronic smoking devices to persons under 21 is borne by the retail entity, entity that holds a retail tobacco permit, or entity registered to sell electronic smoking devices, as opposed to an employee. (SD2)

SB1404, SD2

RELATING TO LOAN REPAYMENT FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS.

LHE, FIN

Expands eligible health care professionals under the health care provider loan repayment program administered through the John A. Burns school of medicine to include licensed social workers, advanced practice registered nurses, and registered nurses. Appropriates funds for the Hawaii rural health care provider loan repayment program administered through the John A. Burns School of Medicine of the University of Hawaii at Manoa; provided that the funds are matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by a private or another public source. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)
