A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AHA MOKU ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that over the past two 1 hundred years, Hawaii has experienced extensive changes, 2 including the deterioration of the Hawaiian culture, language, 3 values, and land tenure system. These changes have contributed 4 5 to the overdevelopment of coastlines, alteration of fresh water 6 streams, destruction of life-giving watersheds, decimation of 7 the coral reefs, and the decline of endemic marine and 8 terrestrial species.

9 The legislature further finds that the aha moku advisory 10 committee was established in 2012 to advise on land and resource 11 management through the aha moku system, a set of best practices 12 based on indigenous knowledge and methodologies.

13 The legislature finds that the aha moku system and the aha 14 moku advisory committee help to ensure responsible stewardship 15 of the State's resources, including its land, watersheds,

16 fishponds, and sea.
