# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DISPLAY OF THE PRISONER OF WAR AND MISSING IN  
ACTION FLAG AT THE STATE CAPITOL.

1           WHEREAS, the National League of Families of American  
2 Prisoners and Missing in Southeast Asia (League) designed a flag  
3 in recognition of the need for a symbol of our prisoner of war  
4 and missing in action military personnel; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, the 101st Congress passed U.S. Public Law 101-355,  
7 which recognized the League's flag, designating it as "the  
8 symbol of our Nation's concern and commitment to resolving as  
9 fully as possible the fates of Americans still prisoner, missing  
10 and unaccounted for in Southeast Asia, thus ending the  
11 uncertainty for their families and the Nation"; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, by law, the flag must be flown on six national  
14 holidays above the country's most important buildings, including  
15 the White House, United States Capitol, and every major military  
16 installation; and

18           WHEREAS, the importance of the League's flag lies in its  
19 continued visibility, a constant reminder of the plight of  
20 America's prisoners of war and missing in action; and

22           WHEREAS, the flag currently flies over the state capitols  
23 in a number of states; now, therefore,


25           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
26 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
27 2019, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Public  
28 Safety, Sheriff Division, is requested to fly the League's flag  
29 year-round at the State Capitol; and
