### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§286-47 Certificate of registration; certificate of

ownership; containers. (a) Upon the registration of a vehicle, 4

the director of finance shall issue a certificate of 5

6 registration to the owner and a certificate of ownership to the

7 legal owner, or to a dealer who shall be a person licensed to

8 sell new motor vehicles under chapter 437 which certificates

9 shall meet the following requirements:

10 Both the certificate of registration and the (1) 11 certificate of ownership shall contain upon the face 12 thereof, the date issued, the registration number 13 assigned to the owner and to the vehicle, the name and 14 address of the owner and legal owner in typewriting, 15 also such description of the registered vehicle as may

be determined by the director of finance. If any of

typographical error, the dealer, as defined in section
437-1.1, shall notify the director of finance of the
error by a written certificate stating the reasons for
and nature of the error and the correction which
should be made in the certificate of registration and
the certificate of ownership. Upon receipt of the
dealer's certificate by the director of finance, the
certificate of registration and the certificate of
ownership shall be corrected accordingly so long as
the correction does not constitute a change of the
vehicle originally registered. A fee shall be paid to
the director of finance for each instance of
correction of the registration records. The fee
charged for each instance of correction of the
registration records shall be established by the
county's legislative body;
In addition to the requirements provided for in
paragraph (1) above, the face of the certificate of
ownership shall contain endorsement lines for the

transfer of title or interest of the registered owner

and legal owner, and the odometer reading of the

2	the certificate of ownership shall contain the
3	application for registration by the transferee $[+]$ .
4	[ <del>(3)(A)</del> ] (b) Every owner shall keep the certificate of
5	registration within the vehicle for which it is registered and
6	shall present the same at the request of a police officer, or in
7	the event the vehicle is a motorcycle, shall carry such
8	certificate in a convenient receptacle attached to the vehicle
9	and which shall be presented at the request of a police officer;
10	provided that this subsection shall not apply to:
