A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that some
 administratively- or statutorily-established non-general funds
 have been altered, amended, repealed, or neglected and are
 effectively non-functional or no longer serve the purpose for
 which they were created.

6 The legislature further finds that the balances languishing
7 in those funds should be transferred to the general fund so that
8 these moneys may be expended to benefit the people of Hawaii.

9 The purpose of this Act is to abolish or repeal certain 10 non-general funds that are no longer necessary, that no longer 11 serve the purpose for which they were created, or for which the 12 establishing authority has expired, and to deposit the 13 unencumbered balances of those funds into the general fund. 14 SECTION 2. On June 30, 2019, the following funds shall be 15 abolished or repealed:

2 and any unencumbered balances shall lapse to the credit of the3 general fund.

4 SECTION 3. The director of finance shall identify any non-5 general funds that are abolished or repealed by this Act and 6 that contain or receive deposits from any federal funding source 7 and transfer the portions of those balances consisting of 8 federal funds into corresponding separate special subaccounts 9 within the general fund to enable the continuation of the 10 purposes funded by the federal funding sources.

11 SECTION 4. It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize 12 the receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of the State or any agency thereof to the holders of any bond 13 issued by the State or by any such agency, and to the extent, 14 and only to the extent, necessary to effectuate this intent, the 15 16 governor may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but shall promptly report the modification with reasons therefor to the 17 legislature at its next session thereafter for review by the 18 19 legislature.

20 SECTION 5. If any provision of this Act, or the
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held



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invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
 of this Act are severable.

5 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
