SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO DESIGNATE THE
HILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AS THE GENERAL ALBERT KUALI'I
BRICKWOOD LYMAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

1 WHEREAS, Hilo International Airport was initially
2 constructed during the 1920s, and began operations in 1929 as
3 "Hilo Airport"; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Hilo Airport was then renamed "General Lyman
6 Field" by joint resolution 5 of the Territorial Legislature on
7 April 19, 1963, to honor Brigadier General Albert Kualii
8 Brickwood Lyman; and
9

10 WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lyman was born on the island of
11 Hawaii on May 5, 1885, and was educated at Kamehameha and
12 Punahou schools and furthered his education at West Point
13 Military Academy; and

15 WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lyman was the first man of
16 Hawaiian ancestry to be appointed a brigadier general of the
17 United States Army and died in Hawaii in the service of his
18 country on August 13, 1942; and

20 WHEREAS, Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 1989, changed the
21 name of the airport to its current name, "Hilo International
22 Airport"; and

24 WHEREAS, Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 1989, further named
25 the passenger terminal "General Lyman Terminal" in memory of
26 Brigadier General Albert Lyman; and

28 WHEREAS, a display case was constructed for General Lyman
29 memorabilia and plaques in July 1992; now, therefore,

31 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
32 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2019, the House of

1 Representatives concurring, that the Department of
 2 Transportation is requested to recognize the significant
 3 accomplishments of the late Brigadier General Albert Kualii
 4 Brickwood Lyman by designating the Hilo International Airport as
 5 the General Albert Kualii Brickwood Lyman International Airport;

 9 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States
 10 Secretary of Transportation, Administrator of the Federal
 11 Aviation Administration, Governor, Director of Transportation,

 13 Hawaii Department of Public Works.
