I. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

This report is prepared and submitted pursuant to the provisions of Senate Resolution (S.R.) No. 102, S.D. 1, 30th Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2019. S.R. No. 102 urges the Harbors Division of the Department of Transportation to inform the maritime community of the procedures to be taken in preparation of a storm and assist with their application for a maritime heavy weather and hurricane plan. The resolution requests that the Harbors Division of the Department of Transportation inform and assist the maritime community with heavy weather and hurricane plan applications, conduct informational meetings, and submit a report to the Legislature on vessels that have submitted applications:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Harbors Division is requested to conduct informational meetings on the islands of Hawaii, Kauai, Maui, and Oahu to inform the maritime community of the necessary procedures to be taken in preparation of a storm; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Harbors Division is requested to submit a list of vessels that have submitted a maritime heavy weather and hurricane plan application to the Legislature no later than twenty Senate Resolution No. 102, S.D.1, 30th Legislature Report to the Legislature December 11, 2019 Page 2
