Annual Report to the Legislature on Administrative Hearing Procedures and Subpoena Power Relating to the Education of Children with a Disability

November 2019

Section 302A-443(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the Department of Education to annually submit a report that provides the total number of requests for a due process hearing relating to the reimbursement of costs for a child's placement filed by a parent or guardian of a child with a disability.

During school year 2018-2019, there were 41 due process hearing requests filed by a parent or guardian of a child with a disability requesting reimbursement of costs for a child's placement.
