## FOREWORD

This publication contains important information concerning the bills passed by the Hawaii State Legislature during the Regular Session of 2020, which adjourned *sine die* on July 10, 2020. This publication supplements the publication entitled "Bills Passed by the Hawaii State Legislature, Regular Session of 2020," which was issued by the LRB Systems Office in early July 2020 and contains a brief description of each bill passed during the 2020 session.<sup>1</sup>

This report consists of the following resources:

- (1) A preliminary index that contains a topical listing of the bills passed during the Regular Session of 2020 under broad and general subject matter categories;
- (2) A table of "Laws Affected by Bills Passed" that shows sections of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, Session Laws of Hawaii, and the proposed constitutional amendments that are affected by bills passed by the Regular Session of 2020. It also includes a listing of new chapters of the Hawaii Revised Statutes. This table reflects information from the final draft of every bill passed by the Legislature during the Regular Session of 2020; and
- (3) A table of "Status of Bills Passed by the Legislature" that provides a listing of bills passed and includes the Act number and approval date, if any, and appropriate committee report numbers.

The foregoing information includes Act numbers and approval dates for bills signed into law or vetoed by the Governor as of August 13, 2020. Information regarding any bills approved by the Governor after August 13, 2020, may be obtained through the Legislature's website at <http://capitol.hawaii.gov/>. The Governor has until September 15, 2020, to consider bills for approval.<sup>2</sup>

The "Supplemental Information" publication for prior years is available through the LRB website, at <https://lrh.hawaii.gov/>. Click on "Publications" at the top of the homepage, and then on "Session Reports."<sup>3</sup> Click on the particular session report year desired and look for the heading "Supplemental Information Relating to Bills Passed."
