A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE ETHICS CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
- 4 "(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
- 5 prohibit a legislator from introducing bills and resolutions.
- 6 from serving on a committee, or from making statements or taking
- 7 official action as a legislator. Every legislator shall
- 8 publicly disclose the nature and extent of the interest or
- 9 transaction that the legislator believes may be affected by the
- 10 legislator's official action[-] in accordance with section 84-17
- 11 and the rules of each house of the legislature."
- 12 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:
- 13 "(d) The state ethics commission shall adopt rules
- 14 pursuant to chapter 91 to effectuate the purposes of this
- 15 section [-], except that each house of the legislature shall
- 16 adopt rules regarding the disclosure of the nature and extent of
- 17 any interest or transaction that the legislator believes may be

- 1 affected by the legislator's official action. Rules adopted by
- 2 the state ethics commission shall apply only until such time
- 3 that each house of the legislature adopts its own rules. Upon
- 4 the passage of rules pursuant to this section by either house of
- 5 the legislature, the rules adopted by the state ethics
- 6 commission shall be preempted by the rules of each respective
- 7 house of the legislature."
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
