A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state fire code
- 2 is among the building codes and standards that compose the state
- 3 building code. The state building code also includes the
- 4 building, residential, plumbing, electrical, energy, and
- 5 elevator codes. Pursuant to chapter 107, Hawaii Revised
- 6 Statutes, the state fire code is first adopted by the state fire
- 7 council and is then adopted by the state building code council,
- 8 a body composed of experts representing designers, contractors,
- 9 industry representatives, and county building, fire, and other
- 10 state regulatory code officials. The state building code
- 11 council is administratively attached to the department of
- 12 accounting and general services. Currently, the department of
- 13 accounting and general services is required to adopt
- 14 administrative rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 15 Statutes, after the building codes are adopted by the state
- 16 building code council. Section 132-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 17 requires the state fire code to be adopted after public hearings



- 1 are conducted pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 2 The other building codes that make up the state building code
- 3 are exempt from the requirement to conduct public hearings.
- 4 Instead, these other building codes are adopted pursuant to
- 5 chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, which requires stakeholders
- 6 to meet and discuss the various building codes in an open forum.
- 7 These state codes form a consistent basis for the adoption of
- 8 building codes for designers, contractors, and the counties.
- 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to repeal the
- 10 requirement that the state fire code be adopted after public
- 11 hearings pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and
- 12 instead require that the code be adopted pursuant to chapter 92,
- 13 Hawaii Revised Statutes, in conformance with all other state
- 14 building codes.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 132-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$132-3 Adoption of state fire code. The state fire
- 18 council shall, [after public hearings pursuant to chapter 91,]
- 19 pursuant to chapter 92 and exempt from the requirements of
- 20 chapter 91, adopt a state fire code setting forth minimum

- 2 from fire loss, including without limitation:
- 3 (1) [the] The storage, handling, and use of hazardous
- 4 substances, materials, and devices; and
- 5 (2) [the] The control of conditions hazardous to life or
- 6 property in the design, use, or occupancy of buildings
- 7 and premises.
- 8 The state fire code shall become part of the Hawaii state
- 9 building codes as provided in section 107-25. The state fire
- 10 council shall meet annually to review and amend the state fire
- 11 code."
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
